AGM

Rosebank Primary School's SGB Annual General Meeting was held on 10th November 2021. A resolution was adopted for **compulsory** school fees for the 2022 year.

The fees for 2022 will be R20 000.00 per learner.

Fees are due and **payable in advance** and are due and payable on the 1st January 2022. If parents are unable to pay the fees upfront, they may be paid in **10 equal** instalments (as resolved at the AGM) commencing on the 1st January and ending the 1st of October 2022. If one instalment is missed and outstanding by the due date, the full outstanding amount of school fees will become due and payable.

Fees may be paid in full by the 31st December 2021 in which a discount of (10%) will be granted:

- **7% if the school fee is paid in full by 31 January 2022**
- **5% if the school fee is paid in full by the 28 February 2022**
- Sibling Discount will be 5% granted in October 2022 **ONLY** on accounts that are up to date.

In terms of Section 40 of the South African Schools Act 84 of 1996 you are liable to pay these fees and the SGB may enforce this payment by taking legal action if the fees are not paid.

Schools Fees are a **statutory** obligation.



The following graphs pulled from the GOOGLE SURVEY show the results of the voting process for the 2022 school fees and resolutions:


Rosebank Primary School remains a fee-paying school?

148 responses




The 2022 school fee will be R20 000, which incorporates an increase of 7.5%.




Annual school fees can be paid over 10 months (January to October).


The SGB is authorised to make payments to state-employed members of staff in terms of Section 38A of SASA as incentives.


The SGB appoints an appropriate auditor to complete the 2021/2022 AFS.


For safety and security, Aftercare is compulsory for all learners who are left unsupervised after the school day.



MASKS

Parents are requested to kindly ensure that children have a spare mask in their bags for emergencies. Many children break their masks and come to the office for a new one. Often, the office must make a plan for the child. Children need to be responsible and remember that we are still in covid times and need to still follow all protocols.



Please also ensure that the mask that your child is wearing is the right size for their face. We have noticed many children wearing masks that are made for an adult's face and therefore too big for a child. This results in the child's mask continuously falling off.

AFTER SCHOOL COLLECTION ON BATH AVE.



We have received an email from concerned residents who stay in the vicinity surrounding the school and who use Bath Ave. The email describes an incident that occurred last week, where a child's parent parked on the opposite side of the street and upon seeing her parent's car, the child just ran across the road without checking for oncoming traffic.

Apparently despite the road warning signs and the fact that there is a school, there was a car that was speeding along Bath Ave. and missed knocking the child over by a mere

centimetre. We have also been informed that UBER drivers use Bath Ave as a Short cut, disobey the road rules and speed along Bath Ave as well.

As a result, we will be implementing a change in the Foundation Phase after school procedure.

ONLY children who use “Rosebank Scholar Transport Association” must go to the gate at the tennis courts. The other Foundation Phase children can be collected from the Foundation Phase pedestrian gate using a “Pick Up and Go “system. We have completed the steps near the pedestrian gate and the FP children can sit on these steps and wait for their parents to pick them up.

We request that you do not park and linger, but rather stop, allow your child time to get into the car and then leave, so that other parents have the space to pick their child up. We also request that as much as possible, parents pick up from the school side of the street and not the opposite side.

Parking from the orange traffic cone set up by The Capital Hotel will be reserved for the “Rosebank Scholar Transport Association “vehicles. These children have been instructed to wait for all the children who go in the same vehicle, either in the vehicle or on the school property. The driver of the relevant vehicle has been asked to monitor the children who he transports.

We further request that parents speak to your children about road safety and how to cross the road safely. While this is covered in Life Skills, children need constant reminders about the dangers they face when crossing the road.
