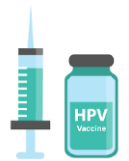

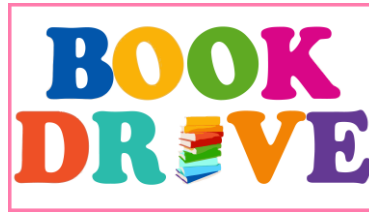
HPV VACCINES FOR GRADE 5 GIRLS

AFTER SCHOOL COLLECTION & DETENTION

Unfortunately, we are experiencing many children hanging around school property after school. When instructed to attend an extra mural activity, some learners refuse. Please note that refusing an instruction from a member of staff is viewed as a transgression. As from Tuesday, 25th April 2023, detentions will be given to any learner not in an extra mural as per school policy. As pointed out many times, we cannot have children hanging around unsupervised in the afternoons. Please discuss the available extra murals with your child and ensure that they know where to go if they are not being collected straight after school. This policy is in the best interests of the safety of all learners while on school property. The Department of Education has given schools the go-ahead to plan for tours this year. The Grades 4-7s will be going on tour after three years due to Covid. These tours are being planned around August and September and are not compulsory. 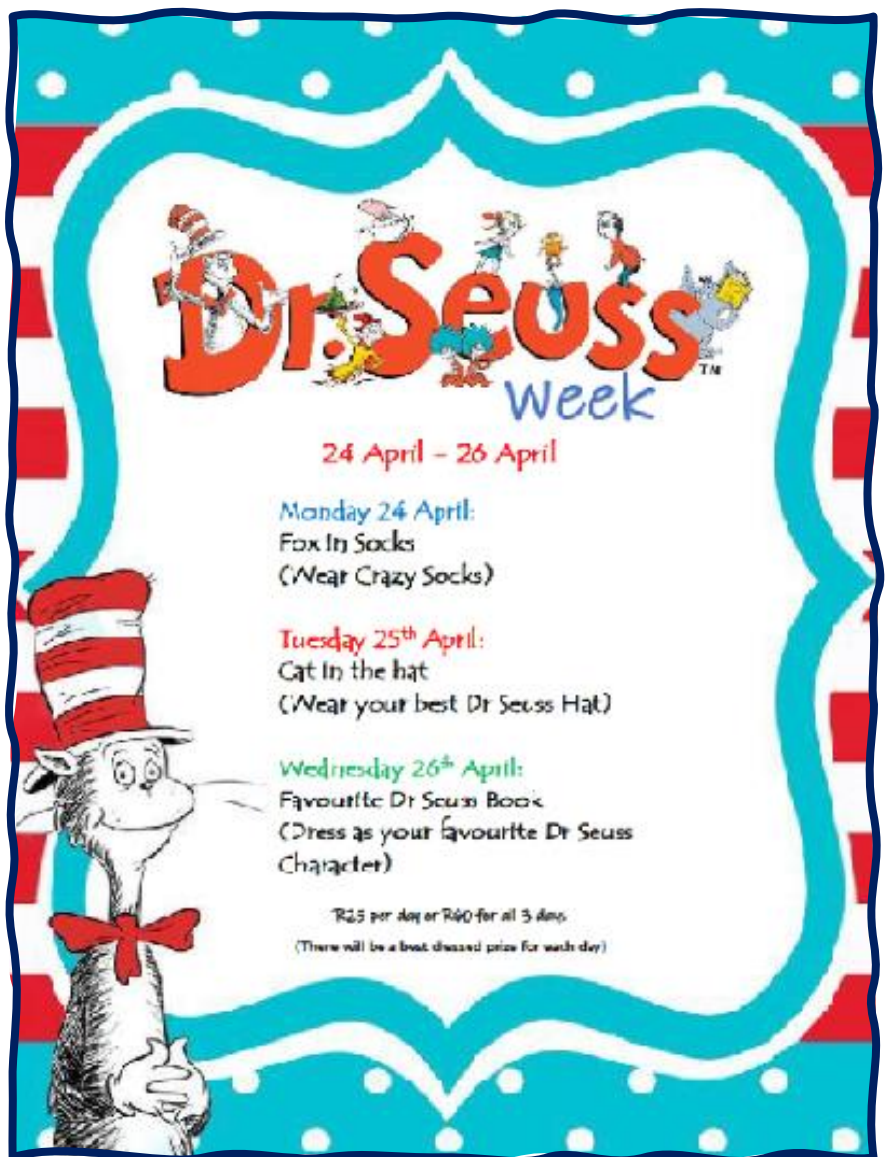
