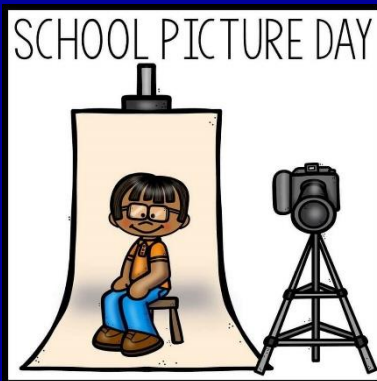

SGB ELECTIONS

Just a friendly reminder that the **SGB elections** are set for **2nd March 2024**.

We must reach a **15% quorum**, which will only be determined at the conclusion of the Elections. If this threshold isn't met, the second meeting will be held on 9th March 2024, where a 15% quorum won't be required.

The official notification will be distributed to all parents today. A printed copy was sent home with your child. Nomination forms will be available for parents to nominate members to the SGB.

Please make sure you've downloaded and **registered on d6**, ensuring your information is accurate on the admin system, as this will serve as the Voters' Roll for the SGB Elections. The d6 Connect App **is free and takes up minimal space with very low data usage**.

Parents and Guardians are asked to have their IDs or passports on hand.

The SGB parent component requires 5 parent members as their representatives.

The Nomination forms will be available from the Front Office. Please collect a form from one of the secretaries and ensure that the form is correctly completed (three people need to complete the nomination form- the person who is nominating a parent member, another parent who agrees with this nomination and then the parent who has been nominated)

The nomination form **MUST** be returned to the office at least 24 hours before the SGB Elections on the 2nd March 2024.

Nominations can also be made at the Nomination Meeting. The person being nominated must be in attendance, as they will be required to sign the form to indicate that they accept the nomination and are prepared to serve on the SGB for the 3-year term of office.
