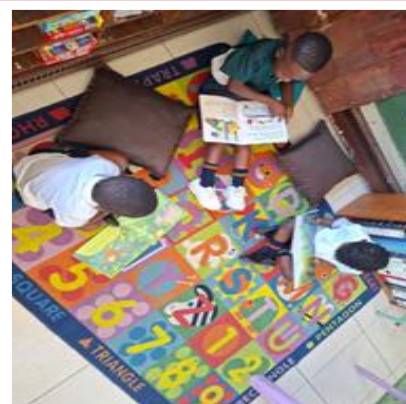

School Fee Payments – 2026



Parents are reminded that school fees must still be paid every month. While the SGB is still working on the budget for 2026 parents are kindly requested **to continue with the payment of the 2026 Resource Fee per phase and the monthly school fees** to ensure a smooth start to the new academic year.

Paying the Resource Fee

The 2026 Resource Fee amounts are as follows:

• **Grade R: R1 000.00 • Grades 1–3: R1 500.00 • Grades 4–7: R1 300.00**

Parents are also encouraged to continue paying the current 2025 school fee rate, which is **R25 252 for Grades 1–7** and **R32 100 for Grade R**. This will help prevent accounts from falling behind and will allow the school to continue meeting its obligations and commitments. Once the 2026 budget has been finalised, any difference will be settled accordingly.

We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your continued support and cooperation.
